

Piotr Ćwik – Governor of the Malopolska Region

He was born in 1968, in Krakow.

He graduated from the Ignatian Academy of Krakow (field of study: philosophy). He also graduated from postgraduate studies: "Management of Education" and "European Consulting".

He first taught religion at the Primary School No. 1 in Skawina, then, in the period from 2000 to 2014, he was the director of the John Paul II Catholic School Complex in Skawina.

He was a member of a council for 20 years, from 1994 to 2006, he served in the City Council in Skawina, and from 2006 to 2014 - in the District Council of Krakow.

During the work of self-government he performed, among others, the function of the chairman of the Education Commission in the City Council in Skawina and the chairman of the Commission for Public Education in the District Council of Krakow.

He was also a Member of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland for the seventh term (2011-2015).

In the Sejm, he worked for the Commission for Education, Science and Youth, the Local Government and Regional Policy Commission, the Special Commission issues related to reducing bureaucracy.

On December 16, 2015, he took over the function of the II Deputy Governor of the Malopolska Region and, on June 3, 2017 - the Governor of the Malopolska Region.

He is married (his wife's name is Anna), with two sons: Piotr and Michał.

He enjoys sports, especially football and volleyball, and hiking.
